E. LATV/High School Progress

Paul shared an update with the Commission: LATV is filming Spirit week, the week of Homecoming at the Forest Lake High School. There are also about 6 other productions planned as well for the upcoming school year. The Press Box is being built in the Sports Center this week. It is paid for entirely by sponsors. The studio for LATV is moving forward. The agreement is that LATV will get to use it as LATV, not just the school. There are teachers that have stepped up to teach classes and the students are interested in doing projects such as podcasts and morning news announcements. The school is looking into college accredited classes for students.

8. ACCESS COORDINATORS REPORT

Paul wanted to know if LATV can hire family members of staff. Dianne stated the personnel policy was more directed towards spouses. Volunteering for LATV is not ideal. If LATV has an employee that is able to work, The employee takes presidence over the volunteer.

Paul questioned if he could film/livestream the Student Mayoral Forum at the high school. This is a political event, but still school based and the school is putting it together. Due to this being a new event and the FLCC has no experience in this area. The commission agreed that filming and airing after the fact is fine but not to live streem the event.

9. CHAIRPERSON REPORT

The topic of reducing FLCC meetings from every month to every other month was discussed. As LATV operations have stabilized: the Commission agreed that monthly meetings are not necessary and can begin alternating months beginning with the November 14th meeting. The meeting date will remain the 2nd Wednesday. The decision will be reviewed periodically.

Dianne was curious about the 2 channels at LATV 10 & 20 and the tentative plan to make changes to them. Paul is finishing up the process of creating the templates and content for Tightrope Carousel which will air exclusively on channel 20, while all video programming will be moved to channel 10 and a new schedule is being created.

Dan is still working on the Joint Powers agreement since Scandia is no longer a part of it. He is working on updating it.

Mara arrived and will be filled in on the entire meeting after the meeting is adjourned.
