## 6. APPROVE TREASURER'S REPORT - October 2021

(ACTION)

- Employer/Personnel expenses 1% over budget to date due to paying health insurance a month ahead
- Film Makers wages are under budget
- Supplies are 23% under budget
- Operating expenses 16% over Budget due to paying Scandia for 2020 accounting services in 2021.
- Misc expense includes personal charges to be reimbursed by year end
- Building rental is on budget (1.5 % annual increase effective for Nov)
- Franchise Reserve is over budget due to a \$30,000 additional transfer in August
- Franchise Fee Revenue: Both cities are current
- PEG/Midco Revenue is 4.5% under budget
- New equipment purchases from PEG Revenue is under budget by 10%. Additional purchases for the year are planned.
- Total cash used YTD is \$27,625.99
- Total Cash disbursements to date \$169.638.81
- Total Revenue to date \$142.012.82
- Cash Balance is \$152,092.67, with reserve: \$212.204.19.
- Cumulative PEG revenue reserved for equipment \$64,511.22
