6. APPROVE TREASURER'S REPORT – July 2021

(ACTION)

- Employer/Personnel expenses 1% under budget to date
- Health Insurance is over budget due to paying a month ahead.
- Disbursements are 10% under budget
- Supplies were 1% over budget due to printer being purchased in January. It will even out throughout the year (\$300)
- Operating expenses 12% under Budget
- New equipment is on budget
- Building rental is on budget
- \$30,000 was transferred to reserve last month
- Revenue is ahead of budget by 5%: Both cities are current
- PEG/Midco Revenue is 3% under budget
- Total cash used YTD is \$24,183.00; primarily for \$30k transfer to reserve
- Cash Balance is \$155,535.96, with reserve: \$215,643.20.
